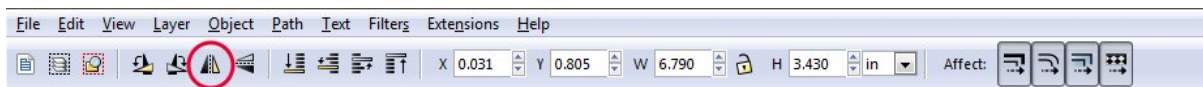


How to Print SVG Designs as a Single Image:

1. Download and install the free program, Inkscape:
<https://inkscape.org/en/download/>
2. Open the SVG file using Inkscape.
3. Go to File menu and choose Document Properties.
4. In the Page tab, change the default unit to inches, then choose the size of paper you will be printing to, then close the Document Properties window.
5. If needed, move the different shapes to configure them how you would like them to print out. Anything that you do not want to print can be moved off the page.
6. Select everything by hitting CTRL A (or COMMAND A on a Mac), grab one of the corners, and holding down the CTRL (or COMMAND) key, resize to the size desired. Make sure every piece is scaled up or down together and proportionally. At the top, the H and W will tell you the size of the object or objects selected. (Default unit is pixels, but you can change it to inches or metric).
7. [Optional] If you wish to change any of the colors, select everything you want to be the same color by using the black arrow tool and holding down the SHIFT key. From the Object menu at the top, choose “Fill and Stroke” and change the color using the fill tab at the right. Repeat for each color you want to change.
8. [Optional] If you need to reverse the image (so that you can print it onto heat transfer paper), select everything by hitting CTRL A (or COMMAND A on a Mac). At the top toolbar, toward the left side, click the mirror icon for “flip selected objects horizontally.” This is a black and yellow triangle, side by side.



9. Load the paper in your printer that you wish to print on. In the File menu, Print.
10. If you wish to save your work, we recommend changing the name of the file so that the original download is left in tact. From the File menu, choose Save As and create a new name for the updated file.
